SUBJECT: Mobile Cranes and Concrete Pumps

This memo is to notify you of recent changes related to mobile cranes and concrete pumps.

Safety Inspections (Annual Inspection Sticker)

Regulation 611 (Safety Inspections) under the Highway Traffic Act has been amended.

The requirement to display an annual inspection sticker as outlined in <u>Section 85</u> of the Highway Traffic Act will come into force on July 1, 2021 for <u>all</u> mobile cranes and concrete pumps, regardless of vehicle configuration.

During the coming months, all mobile cranes and concrete pumps must undergo an inspection at a licenced Motor Vehicle Inspection Station to ensure that they comply when the regulation comes into force.

All mobile cranes and concrete pumps must display a valid annual inspection sticker on **July 1, 2021**.
